WELLNESS MANDATES:

Here at BBNS Academy, our student's health is of utmost importance to us so, if your child is presenting with flu like symptoms (runny nose, fever, cough, sneeze), COVID 19 symptoms (no smell or taste, shortness of breath, etc), or any mild or severe presence of head lice, please do not bring them to school. We will be checking students for these symptoms at the door, and as a previous practice, parents will not be permitted to leave from AM drop off until they receive a thumbs up from our staff that their child(ren) are good to go. If your child presents with any ailments, they will be turned around and sent home for the day until further notice (please refer to your parent policy handbook for more information). Additionally, starting October 3rd, BBNS Academy will resume its mask mandate. This means that our students will be required to wear a mask while in the building. This also means that parents will be asked to wear a mask while dropping off and picking up their students. This mandate will be in effect immediately, and until further notice. With this, please send your child(ren) to school with additional and appropriately sized masks for their face. These masks can be paper masks and/or reusable cloth masks.

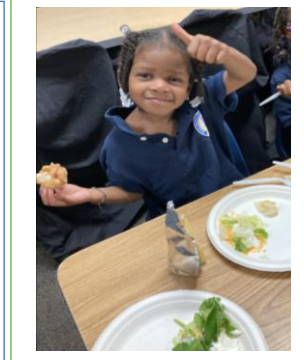

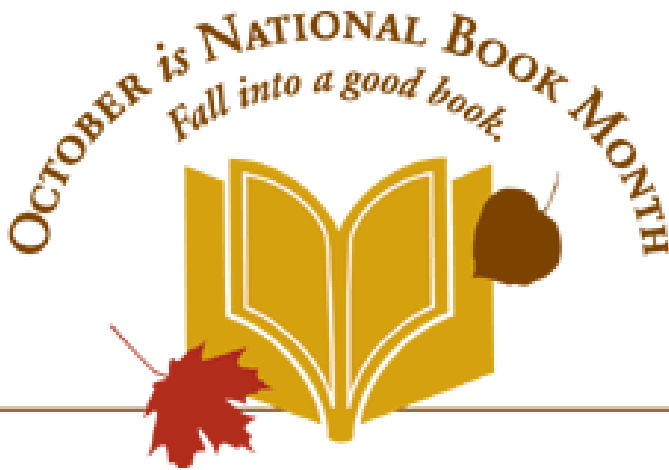
BBNS ACADEMY SAYS, "THANK YOU"!

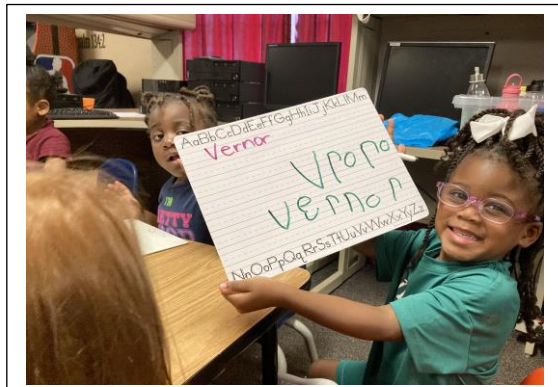
